

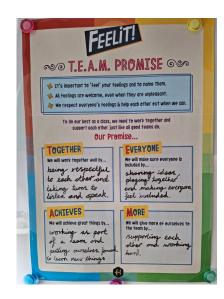
# CASE STUDY British Junior Academy of Brussels

The British Junior Academy of Brussels (BJAB) is an expanding British International school in the heart of Brussels. It has a community of families from all over the globe, and is an active member of COBIS. They have been using The Happy Confident whole school programme since February 2023, across all years from Reception to Year 9.

According to Head Teacher, Francis Retter, the FEELIT programme has been embedded into their curriculum with ease, thanks to the clear planning and guidance notes provided by The Happy Confident Company. ## **CREATING A SAFE SPACE**

The TFAM Promise has become an integral part of every classroom at BJAB. Before embarking on the FEELIT Programme, pupils establish their own rules and using the TEAM Promise they demonstrate their commitment to creating the most positive space for sharing their feelings and experiences. This alone has been an amazing tool for fostering compassion within class and the wider school community, and has led to some amazing discussions between pupils, and with their teachers.



### **HAPPY CONFIDENT ME TIME**

The FEELIT Mapper is used daily with all classes, and the school have allocated time each day for dedicated Happy Confident Me (HCM) time. This has become a routine that pupils very much look forward to. Within the primary school, HCM Time has been slotted in during circle time with their youngest pupils and during tutor time with their eldest pupils. At secondary level they have launched vertical tutor groups and the programme works really effectively, as pupils support and learn from each other.

### **REAPING THE BENEFITS**

BJAB are now reaping the rewards of creating positive daily habits with their pupils - their HCM Time is one such example of these daily habits.

They have also noticed a significant positive shift in the behaviour and attitude of pupils since using the programme, They reported as having had some wonderful restorative conversations with pupils when inevitable mishaps occur. The FEELIT Programme helps develop pupils' emotional literacy and the highly nuanced language they are now learning from the very youngest age, is enabling pupils to express how they are feeling and acknowledge what triggered their actions. This has led to a better learning environment for all.
